- As an academic center for research and innovation, the UP is leading Kosovo's development in several scientific areas, including public policies, capacity building and scientific research

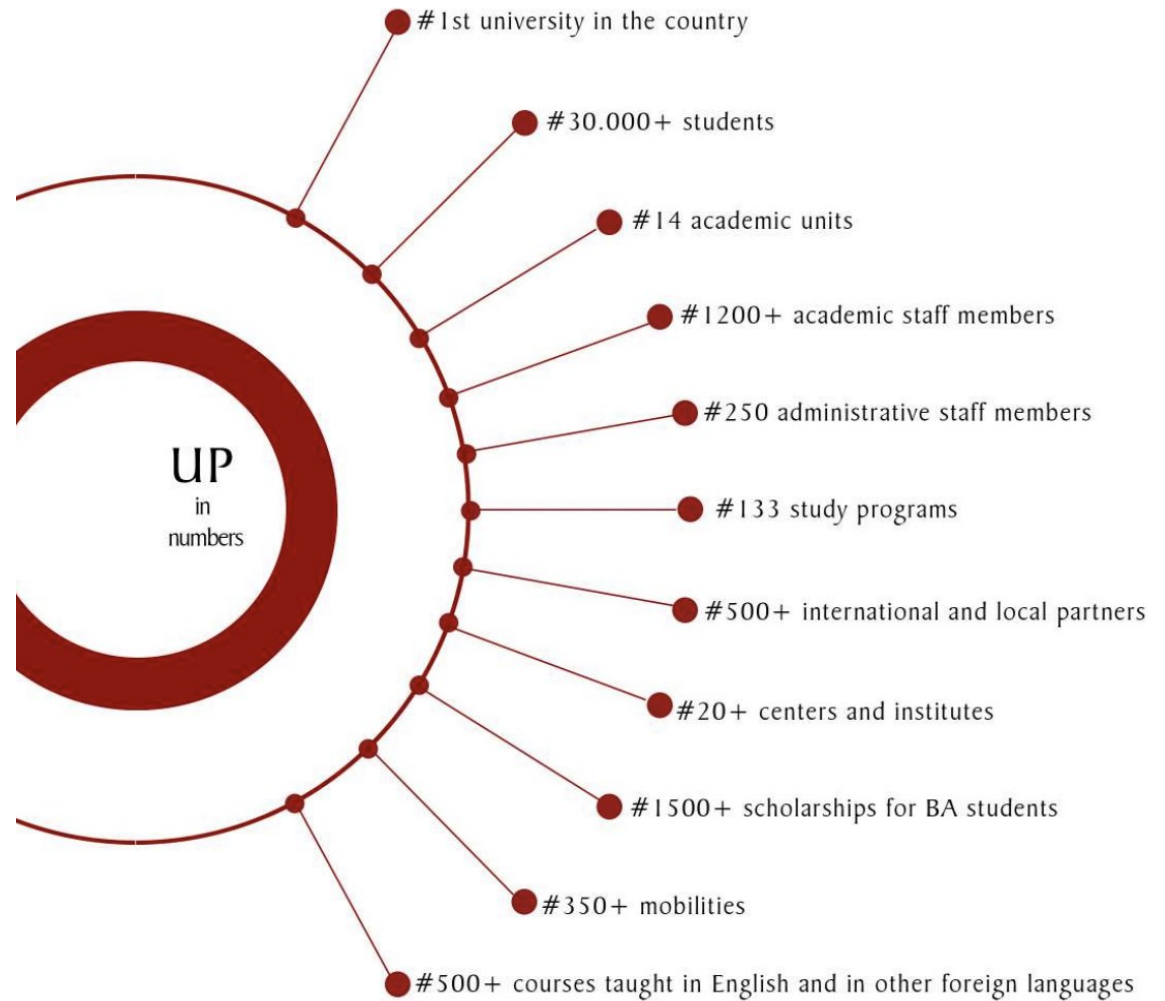

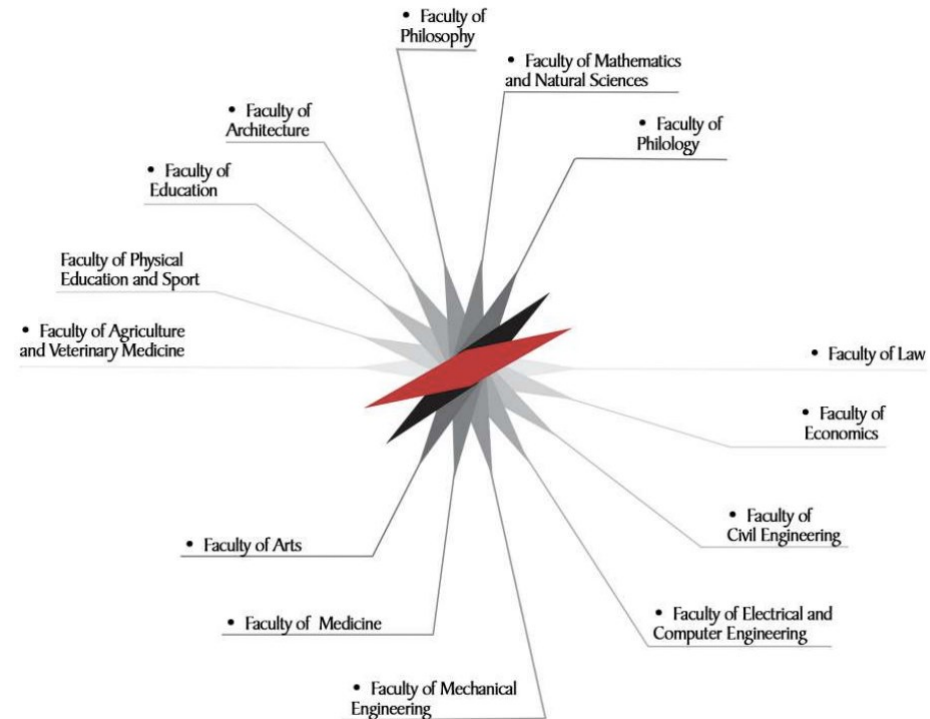

- The BA Political Science program dates back to 2001. In 2009, the BA program was reaccredited and redesigned in collaboration with the Universities of Salzburg (Austria) and Pavia (Italy).
- The Department of Political Science has offered study programs, at the BA and MA levels, such as Political Science and Public Administration (BA), Civil Society and Local Development (MA), Political Science (BA), with specialization in Relations International or in Public Administration, International Relations and Diplomacy (MA), as well as the English language program European Studies and Public Administration (MA).

International Credit mobility

ERASMUS + program represents a unique opportunity for investing in human capital development and further Kosovo's role as EU partner and promoter of cultural diplomacy.

In cooperation with EU institutions, the University of Prishtina has been awarded several bilateral projects within the ERASMUS+ International Credit Mobility program.

Inter-institutional cooperation

- The University of Prishtina “Hasan Prishtina” aims to create co-operation with regional and international universities. The UP has signed general agreements that support the following forms of co-operation:
 - student and faculty exchange;
 - exchange of administrative and professional staff;
 - joint organization of courses, study tours, conferences and seminars.
 - participation in scientific conferences, symposia, and seminars:
 - joint research projects, including applications for governmental and foundation funding;
 - exchange of experience and information on the syllabi, methodology of teaching and techniques applied to didactic process;
 - other forms of university co-operation of mutual interest.

Courses taught in English

- University of Prishtina 'Hasan Prishtina' consists of 14 faculties. Depending on your field of study, you will be officially enrolled at one of these faculties during your stay.
- Every faculty offers a variety of courses and seminars in English, German, Italian and other foreign Languages. Most of the faculties present the lists of courses on their websites. The offer usually remains very similar each year.

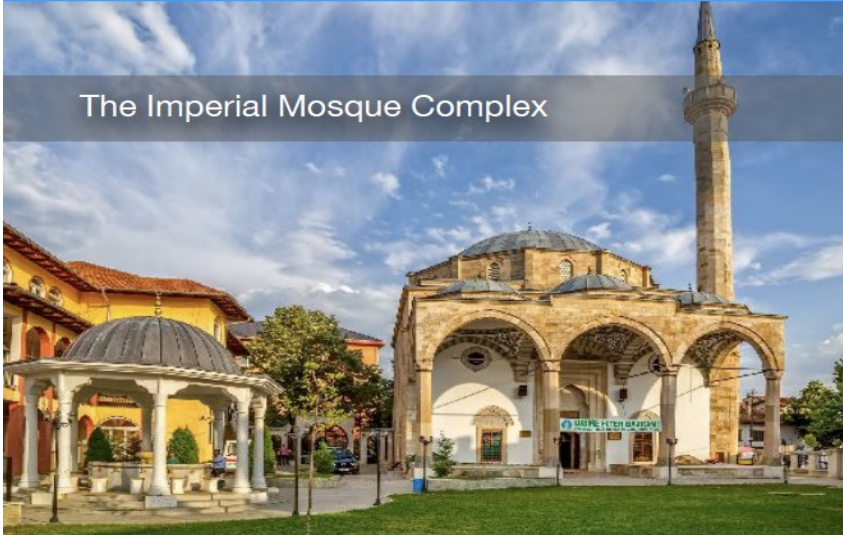
