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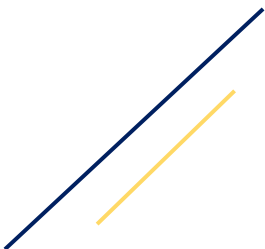

Mobility programmes and Opportunities

Most of the lectures at the UoM are held in Montenegrin language. A certain number of courses are provided in English language in the form of lectures organized as individual consultations with respective professors.

UoM offers three accredited programme in English language: International PhD Studies in Sustainable Development, Bachelor Academic Programme in Business and Administration – Monteb, Master programme in Information Security.

During mobility, outgoing students are encouraged to contact home IRMO for every question or misunderstanding that may appear.

After the mobility, students are provided with all details regarding the recognition procedure.

Staff mobility participants are provided with detailed information about the application procedure.

Visa and Residence Permit

EU CITIZENS

Students, who are citizens of the EU, can enter Montenegro with a valid passport. Within 24 hours after arrival, they must register their stay at the Tourist Organisation in the city of stay. After registration, students are obliged to start the procedure for obtaining a temporary stay permit at the Ministry of Interior Affairs.

NON-EU CITIZENS

Students, who are nationals of NON-EU countries, are obliged to obtain a visa in their home country or the nearest neighboring country where there is an Embassy of Montenegro before their departure to Montenegro. Upon their arrival in Montenegro, students must register in the Tourist Organisation within the 24 hours. After registration, they must start the procedure for obtaining residence permit for a temporary stay.

Accommodation and Cafeterias

Important info

- **Meal System:** Student card with loaded meal credits
 - **Meal Cost:** Around 1 euro each (breakfast, lunch, dinner)
 - **Monthly Purchase:** Unlimited, but meals expire on the 10th
 - **Purchase Restrictions:** Not available from the 25th to the 1st
- Operating Hours:
- **Monday to Saturday:** 7 am to 8.30 pm
 - **Sunday:** 7 am to 1 pm
- **Takeaway:** Possible, bring your own packaging

Contact the International Relations Office

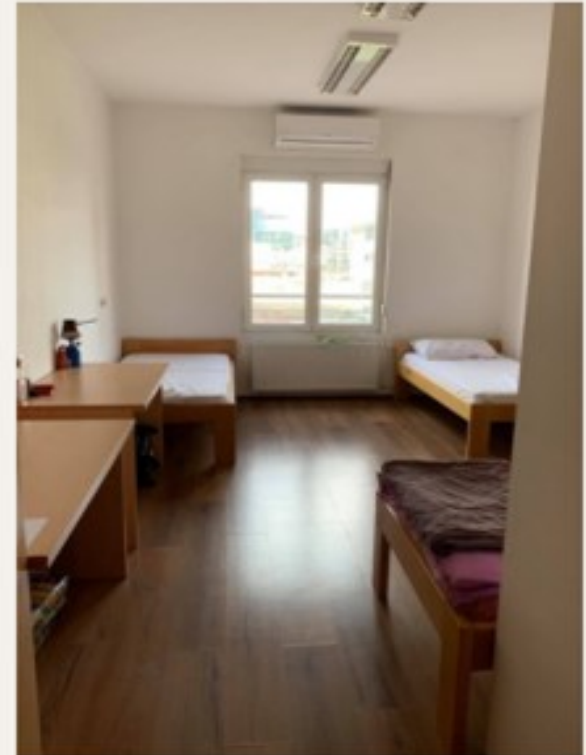
Send a formal request to the international office expressing your desire to stay at the Novi Dorm. Include your personal details, expected duration of stay, and any preferences you may have.
