IRMO is open for **consultation on a daily basis**.


Pre-departure day - one month before the start of the mobility semester with an aim to prepare students for their exchange experience



Accommodation and Cafeterias

Important info

- · Meal System: Student card with loaded meal credits
- . Meal Cost: Around 1 euro each (breakfast, lunch, dinner)
- Monthly Purchase: Unlimited, but meals expire on the 10th
- Purchase Restriction: Not available from the 25th to the 1st

Operating Hours:

- Monday to Saturday: 7 am to 8.30 pm
- Sunday: 7 am to 1 pm
- Takeaway: Possible, bring your own packaging

Dormitory Accommodation

Planning to stay at the Novi Dorm in Podgorica? Excellent choice! To secure a spot, make sure to submit a request to the international office as soon as possible. Here's a step-by-step guide to make your dormitory experience smooth:

Initiate the process early

Start by reaching out to the international office well in advance. The demand for dormitory accommodation can be high, so it's crucial to express your interest early on.



Contact the International Relations Office

Send a formal request to the international office expressing your desire to stay at the Novi Dorm. Include your personal details, expected duration of stay, and any preferences you may have.

Once your request is submitted, patiently wait for confirmation from the international office. They will provide information on whether a spot is available, along with any additional instructions or forms required.
