Marco Gori received his PhD in 1990 from the University of Bologna, Italy, doing part of his research at the McGill University School of Computer Science in Montreal. He is currently Full Professor of Computer Science at the University of Siena, where he directs the Siena Artificial Intelligence Lab. He is mainly interested in Artificial Intelligence, with a focus on Machine Learning and recent generative and creative processes.

The impact of his research on neural networks has mainly emerged from his recent interest in graph neural networks, which he helped introduce in the article 'Graph Neural Networks', IEEE-TNN, 2009. To date, the article has received about 9,000 citations (about 6-7 citations per day in recent years).

Professor Gori is a past president of the Italian Chapter of the IEEE Computation Intelligence Society and president of the Italian Association for Artificial Intelligence.

He is a Fellow of IEEE, EurAl, IAPR and ELLIS.
