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The Health Record (FSE) Project and, more generally, health digitisation is constantly evolving; a series of regulatory measures are taking place for the full implementation and realisation of the Health Record 2.0, the analysis of which is therefore of extreme interest.

Although the interpreters have not yet finished studying the text of the important and strategic 'FSE Decree 2.0' of September 2023, amendments have already been made to enable its effective and full implementation. Last 18th November, after having expired last June, the deadlines were reopened for opposing the feeding of the Health Record with digital data and documents generated by clinical events prior to 19th May 2020, in order to allow certain categories of patients who had previously been excluded to exercise this option.

New challenges and commitments once again await all players in the national health system, including those who, like the APIHM community, are committed to ensuring that health data, the cornerstone of digital health, are handled with the most advanced technologies while fully respecting the rights of the patient, ensuring confidentiality and security.
