Course Description

Non-melanoma skin cancers are the most frequent cancers in humans. Identifying persons at risk and early diagnosis remain key strategies in reducing morbidity and progression. Several treatments for early forms of skin cancers are currently available ranging from emollients to lasers and minimal surgery and profound knowledge of how to choose the most effective treatment is required. However, the discovery of targeted and immunotherapies also revolutionized the treatment of locally advanced and metastatic forms of skin cancer. This interactive course is delivered by renowned world experts and intends to give a comprehensive overview and practical insights on how to best fight NMSC according to the newest guidelines and based on individual case presentations.
